## **NEWSTEAD WOOD MOCK - SAMPLE ANSWERS AND EXPLANATIONS**

- 1. B
- 2. B Score can mean "twenty" and can also mean "to cut or scratch a line on a surface".
- 3. A John is 21, Nathan is 22 and Frank is 31.
- 4. D Calvin must be 2 years younger than Tommy (20 minus 18). Therefore, if Tommy is 30, Calvin is 28.
- 5. A T to V is forwards 2 letters. Forwards 2 letters from E gives G. Z to W is backwards 3 letters. Backwards 3 letters from N is K. Therefore, answer is GK.
- 6. A Count forwards 3, backwards 4, forwards 3, etc. from each letter in COIN.
- 7. C Using the codes provided, L = E, A = T, T = O, E = S, S = Q and T = O. Unlike question 6, do not count on from individual letters.
- 8. D GREED = 70446, BORED = 39046, EDGES = 46748.
- 9. E as above.
- 10. E HUMILITY is an abstract noun. BOASTFUL is incorrect as it is an adjective, therefore PRIDE is the correct answer (also an abstract noun).
